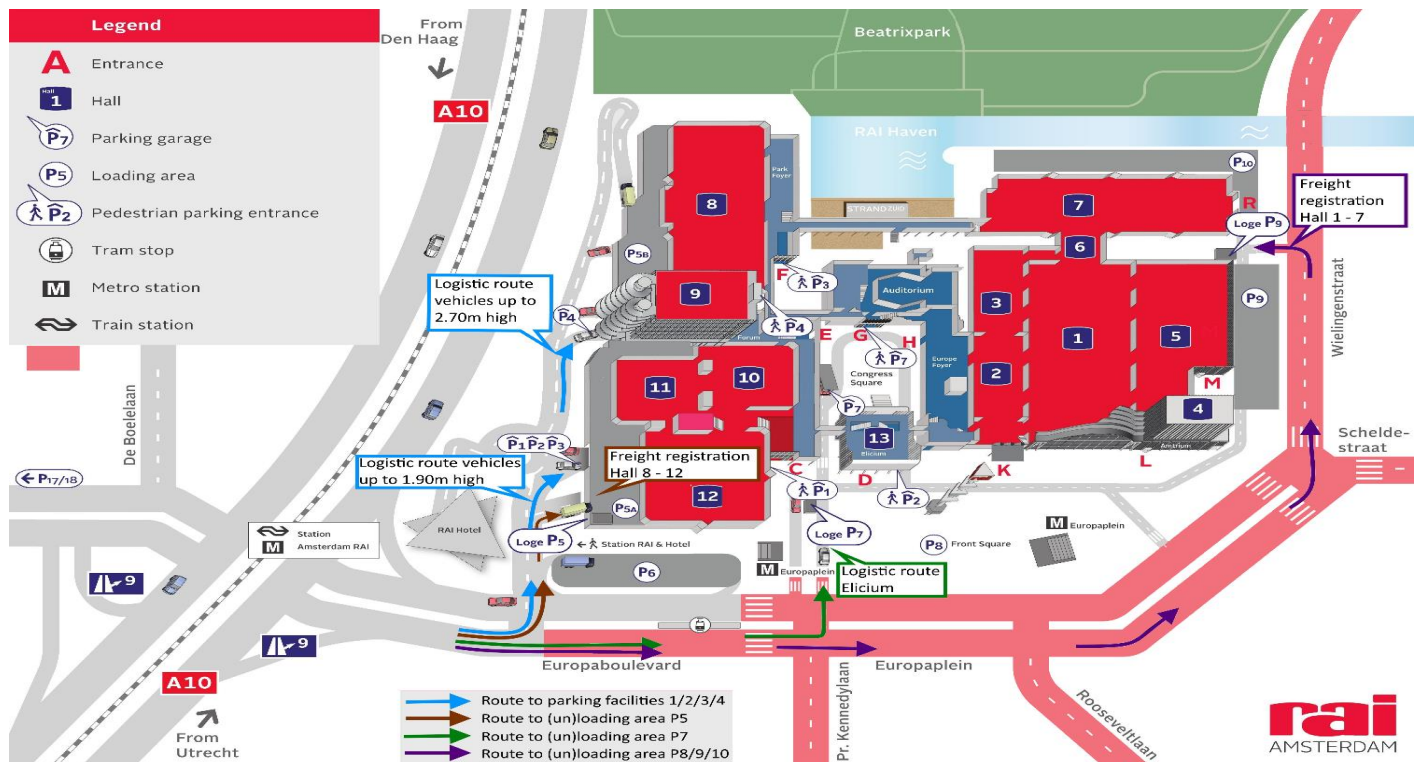

In the period from May 21st to August 31st, the local authority of Amsterdam will be conducting necessary construction work on the Europaboulevard.
